An Historical Geography of France - Xavier de Planhol 1994-03-17
In this 1994 book, Xavier de Planhol and Paul Claval, two of France's leading scholars in the field, trace the historical geography of their country from its roots in the Roman province of Gaul to the 1990s. They demonstrate how, for centuries, France was little more than an ideological concept, despite its natural physical boundaries and long territorial history. They examine the relatively late development of a more complex territorial geography, involving political, religious, cultural, agricultural and industrial unities and diversities. The conclusion reached is that only in the twentieth century had France achieved a profound territorial unity and only now are the fragmentations of the past being overwritten.

Memoirs of a Breton Peasant - Jean-Marie Deguignet 2004-02-03

A fascinating document of an extraordinary life, Memoirs of A Breton Peasant reads with the liveliness of a novel and bristles with the vigor of an opinionated autodidact from the very lowest level of peasant society. Brittany during the nineteenth century was a place seemingly frozen in the Middle Ages, backwards by most French standards; formal education among rural society was either unavailable or dismissed as unnecessary, while the church and local myth defined most people's reasoning and motivation. Jean-Marie Déguignet is unique not only as a literate Breton peasant, but in his skepticism for the church, his interest in science, astronomy and languages, and for his keen—often caustic—observations of the world and people around him. Born into rural poverty in 1834, Déguignet escapes Brittany by joining the French Army in 1854, and over the next fourteen years he fights in the Crimean war, attends Napoleon III's coronation ceremonies, supports Italy's liberation struggle, and defends the hapless French puppet emperor Maximilian in Mexico. He teaches himself Latin, French, Italian and Spanish and reads extensively on history, philosophy, politics, and literature. He returns home to live as a farmer and tobacco-seller, eventually falling back into dire poverty. Throughout the tale, Deguignet's freethinking, almost anarchic views put him ahead of his time and often (sadly, for him) out of step with his contemporaries. Déguignet's voluminous journals (nearly 4,000 pages in total) were discovered in a farmhouse in Brittany a century after they were written. This narrative was drawn from them and became a surprise bestseller when published in France in 1998.

La 4e de couverture indique: "Revenant sur son installation comme agriculteur exploitant, Jacques Le Roy Ladurie disait : " J'ai découvert le monde paysan, mon maître, et, entre 23 et 80 ans, je lui ai consacré 100% de mon activité ". Né en 1902 d'une famille bourgeoise où l'on sert Dieu et la Patrie au prix parfois de douloureux dilemmes, le jeune homme rejoint la mouvance des associations rurales constituées aux termes de la loi de 1884. S'il pratique le " syndicat-boutique " - qui fournit engrais, petit matériel, assurances, épicerie - " Maît'Jacques " fait mesurer leur interdépendance à ses camarades normands : " Les familles paysannes, toutes sans distinction, s'y retrouvent, car toutes se sentent menacées dans un siècle qui ne semble pas fait pour elles ". En 1932, il commence à parcourir la France ; en 1934, l'Union Nationale des Syndicats Agricoles (UNSA, 1 million de familles associées) fait de lui son secrétaire général. Prétendant " franchir l'étape des critiques faciles, atteindre celle plus malaisée des solutions constructives ", il milite à faire de l'agriculture française une vaste corporation libre de toute inféodation. Dans

l'éprouvante incertitude de l'entre-deux-guerres, il veut rendre espérance et foi en la France aux 20 millions des Français les plus éprouvés par les tueries de 14-18. " JLRL " parle, écrit beaucoup. Mine d'informations sur le monde rural, courriers et articles nourrissent le présent ouvrage. L'homme a un entregent formidable, séduit par son allant, ses compétences. Grand gaillard d'un mètre quatre-vingt-cinq au regard droit, l'apôtre de la révolution corporative n'a rien du petit saint besogneux !" **Bulletin officiel - France. Ministère du travail 1913**

Memoirs from Beyond the Grave - François-René de Chateaubriand 2018-02-20

Written over the course of four decades, François-René de Chateaubriand's epic autobiography has drawn the admiration of Baudelaire, Flaubert, Proust, Roland Barthes, Paul Auster, and W. G. Sebald. In this unabridged section of the Memoirs, spanning the years 1768 to 1800, Chateaubriand looks back on the already bygone world of his youth. He recounts the history of his aristocratic family and the first rumblings of the French Revolution. He recalls playing games on the beaches of Saint-Malo, wandering in the woods near his father's castle in Combourg, hunting with King Louis XVI at Versailles, witnessing the first heads carried on pikes through the streets of Paris, meeting with George Washington in Philadelphia, and falling hopelessly in love with a young woman named Charlotte in the small Suffolk town of Bungay. The volume ends with Chateaubriand's return to France after eight years of exile in England. In this new edition (the first unabridged translation of any portion of the Memoirs to be published in more than a century), Chateaubriand emerges as a writer of great wit and clarity, a self-deprecating egoist whose meditations on the meaning of history, memory, and morality are leavened with a mixture of high whimsy and memorable gloom.
