La progression pédagogique choisie par les auteurs débute par l'installation de Node sur les trois grands systèmes d'exploitation (GNU/Linux, OS X et Windows) puis couvre le fonctionnement du gestionnaire de paquets « ; npm », qui est le compagnon quotidien du développeur Node, et la présentation des concepts essentiels de la plateforme. Les chapitres suivants présentent les puissants paradigmes que sont les flux et les promesses puis enchaînent sur des explications pratiques concernant la manipulation de fichiers et l'utilisation de bases de données.
