The development of such a device is a challenging task, because each of the insulation materials can play an important role in its breakdown behavior. Within this work, an inductive data coupler from Infineon Technologies AG was optimized to meet the requirements of reinforced isolation concerning high field robustness in a wide range of environments. Within the course of this optimization, a large variety of breakdown mechanisms were investigated and analyzed under

high electric fields.
