QUICK REFLEXES AND SELF-CONFIDENCE ARE ESSENTIAL: STREET PHOTOGRAPHERS KNOW FROM EXPERIENCE THAT HESITATION OR PROCRASTINATION COULD MEAN MISSING A ONCE-IN-A-LIFETIME SHOT. THE ADAGE "IT'S BETTER TO ASK FOR FORGIVENESS THAN PERMISSION" WAS PROBABLY COINED BY A STREET PHOTOGRAPHER. IN STREET PHOTOGRAPHY: THE ART OF CAPTURING THE CANDID MOMENT, GORDON LEWIS HELPS READERS UNDERSTAND AND CONQUER THE CHALLENGING YET REWARDING WORLD OF STREET PHOTOGRAPHY.
