According to some observers, Southeast Asian Islam is undergoing a conservative turn. This means voices that champion humanist, progressive or moderate ideas are located on the fringes of society. Is this assessment accurate for a region that used to be known for promoting the "smiling face of Islam"? Alternative Voices in Muslim Southeast Asia examines the challenges facing progressive voices in Indonesia, Malaysia and Singapore today. It examines their discourses, which delve into how multiculturalism and secularism are the way forward for the diverse societies of these three countries. Moreover, it analyses the avenues employed by these voices in articulating their views amidst the dominance of state and quasi-state religious officials who seek to restrict and discipline them. Contributors to the volume include scholars, activists and observers, some of whom are victims of repression and discrimination. While

most of the chapters cover developments of the last decade, some of them go back to the previous century, capturing the emergence of modernist thinkers influenced by parallel movements in the Middle East and the wider region. Others respond to recent developments concerning Islam and Muslims in the three countries: the Pakatan Harapan coalition victory in the 2018 Malaysian election, the re-election of Joko Widodo as Indonesia's president in 2019, and recent religious rulings passed in Singapore. Readers should come not only to reflect on the struggles faced by this group but also to appreciate the humanist traditions essential for the development of the societies of these countries in the midst of change.

Principles of Pragmatics - Geoffrey N. Leech 2016-02-17

Over the years, pragmatics - the study of the use and meaning of utterances to their situations - has become a more and more important branch of linguistics, as the inadequacies of a purely formalist, abstract approach to the study of language have become more evident. This book presents a rhetorical model of pragmatics: that is, a model which studies linguistic communication in terms of communicative goals and principles of 'good communicative behaviour'. In this respect, Geoffrey Leech argues for a rapprochement between linguistics and the traditional discipline of rhetoric. He does not reject the Chomskian revolution of linguistics, but rather maintains that the language system in the abstract - i.e. the 'grammar' broadly in Chomsky's sense - must be studied in relation to a fully developed theory of language use. There is therefore a division of labour between grammar and rhetoric, or (in the study of meaning) between semantics and pragmatics. The book's main focus is thus on the development of a model of pragmatics within an overall functional model of language. In this it builds on the speech act theory of Austin and Searle, and the theory of conversational implicature of Grice, but at the same time enlarges pragmatics to include politeness, irony, phatic communion, and other social principles of

linguistic behaviour.

Pada 20 November 1979, sebuah peristiwa besar terjadi di Kota Suci Mekkah. Sekelompok orang bersenjata pimpinan Juhaiman al-Utaibi, seorang Islamis radikal, menguasai Masjid al-Haram. Mereka memprotes kebobrokan Pemerintah Arab Saudi dan aliansinya dengan Barat. Gejolak politik di tanah suci meledak. Sebagai hukumannya, Juhaiman dan pengikutnya yang tertangkap hidup-hidup kemudian dipenggal kepalanya--eksekusi penggal kepala ini dilaksanakan di beberapa kota di Saudi sebagai peringatan bagi

siapa pun yang berusaha makar terhadap pemerintah. Merujuk fatwa para ulama berpengaruh, Pemerintah Saudi mendakwa mereka melakukan tindakan sesat: mendeklarasikan munculnya Imam Mahdi--yang tewas dalam pertempuran itu--sebagai penyelamat dunia; serta menguasai dan menjadikan Masjid al-Haram, tempat tersuci umat Muslim, sebagai medan pertempuran dan kekerasan, yang sangat jelas dilarang oleh agama. Peristiwa itu menjadi bagian penting dari sejarah modern Kota Mekkah. Meski demikian, kebanyakan orang, terutama kaum Muslim, tak paham apa yang sejatinya terjadi saat itu. Maklum, ketika peristiwa itu berlangsung, Pemerintah Saudi melarang keras media massa meliput dan memberitakannya. Tak hanya itu, jaringan telepon, telegram, dan surat-menyurat pun diputus. Alhasil, tak ada celah bagi siapa pun untuk dapat mengakses peristiwa itu dari luar tempat kejadian. Pada tahun 2006, dua puluh tahun kemudian, Yaroslav Trofimov berusaha menyusun kembali serpihan sejarah atas kejadian itu. Untuk menyibak detail peristiwa yang tak terkuak khalayak itu, Trofimov memburu sumber-sumber penting dan tepercaya, antara lain: pelaku 'gerakan 1979' yang masih hidup; Paul Barril, kepala misi pasukan Prancis saat itu; tentara Arab Saudi; Perpustakaan British, satu-satunya tempat di Eropa yang menyimpan pelbagai surat kabar Saudi tahun 1979; arsip Pemerintah AS dan Inggris yang berisi laporan rahasia dari para diplomat dan mata-mata; serta CIA dan British Foreign Office. Para pengamat politik dan sejarawan menganggap kejadian itu sebagai insiden lokal semata dan karena itu tak bersangkutan-paut dengan peristiwa internasional yang belakangan merebak: terorisme. Tetapi penulis buku ini, Yaroslav Trofimov, berpendapat sebaliknya. Menurutnya,

peristiwa itu merupakan akar sejarah gerakan terorisme global, terutama yang dimotori al-Qaeda. Siapa dan di mana Osama Bin Laden kala itu, sehingga petinggi al-Qaeda ini dihubung-kaitkan dengan peristiwa tersebut? Padahal ketika peristiwa itu terjadi, keluarga besar Bin Laden termasuk dalam barisan Pemerintah Kerajaan Arab Saudi yang mendukung penumpasan gerakan 1979.

societies. The subject of this title is the Padri movement, and the community involved is that of the Minangkabau of Central Sumatra, one of the major communities inhabiting the Indonesian archipelago. In the process of considering the reconstruction of a society in the throes of an agricultural

transformation, the historical development of the Indonesian village became the object of attention, encompassing the economic and social histories of individual villages. This title will be of interest to students of history and Islamic Studies.
