BASED ON NEW EMPIRICAL RESEARCH, THE AUTHORS IN THIS COLLECTION EXPLORE THESE THREE PROCESSES AND THEIR CONSEQUENCES FOR BOTH MEMBER AND NON-MEMBER EU STATES, FOR MIGRANTS THEMSELVES, AND FOR MIGRATION SYSTEMS IN THE REGION.
