FEATURING BLACK HUSBANDS WITH WHITE WIVES AS WELL AS BLACK WIVES WITH WHITE HUSBANDS, BOUNDARIES OF LOVE SHEDS LIGHT ON THE ROLE OF GENDER IN NAVIGATING LIFE MARRIED TO A PERSON OF A DIFFERENT COLOR. OSUJI COMPARES BLACK-WHITE COUPLES IN BRAZIL AND THE UNITED STATES, THE TWO MOST POPULOUS POST-SLAVERY SOCIETIES IN THE WESTERN HEMISPHERE. THESE SETTINGS, SHE ARGUES, REVEAL THE IMPACT OF CONTEMPORARY RACE MIXTURE ON RACIAL HIERARCHIES AND RACIAL IDEOLOGIES, BOTH OLD AND NEW.

THERE HAS BEEN A TENDENCY AMONGST FEMINISTS TO SEE DOMESTIC WORK AS THE GREAT LEVELLER, A COMMON BURDEN IMPOSED ON ALL WOMEN EQUALLY BY PATRIARCHY. THIS UNIQUE STUDY OF MIGRANT DOMESTIC WORKERS IN THE NORTH UNCOVERS SOME UNCOMFORTABLE FACTS ABOUT THE RACE AND CLASS ASPECTS OF DOMESTIC OPPRESSION. BASED ON ORIGINAL RESEARCH, IT LOOKS AT THE RACIALISATION OF PAID DOMESTIC LABOUR IN THE NORTH - A PHENOMENON WHICH CHALLENGES FEMINISM AND POLITICAL THEORY AT A FUNDAMENTAL LEVEL. THE BOOK OPENS WITH AN EXPLORATION OF THE PUBLIC/PRIVATE DIVIDE AND AN OVERVIEW OF THE DEBATES ON WOMEN AND POWER. THE AUTHOR GOES ON TO PROVIDE A MAP OF EMPLOYMENT PATTERNS OF MIGRANT WOMEN IN DOMESTIC WORK IN THE

NORTH; SHE DESCRIBES THE WORK THEY PERFORM, THEIR LIVING AND WORKING CONDITIONS AND THEIR EMPLOYMENT RELATIONS. A CHAPTER ON THE US EXPLORES THE CONNECTIONS BETWEEN SLAVERY AND CONTEMPORARY DOMESTIC SERVICE WHILE A SECTION ON COMMODIFICATION EXAMINES THE EXTENT TO WHICH MIGRANT DOMESTIC WORKERS ARE NOT SELLING THEIR LABOUR BUT THEIR WHOLE PERSONHOOD. THE BOOK ALSO LOOKS AT THE ROLE OF THE OTHER IN MANAGING DIRT, DEATH AND POLLUTION AND THE EFFECTS OF THE FEMINISATION OF THE LABOUR MARKET - AS MIDDLE CLASS WHITE WOMEN HAVE GREATER PRESENCE IN THE PUBLIC SPHERE, THEY ARE MORE LIKELY TO PUSH RESPONSIBILITY FOR DOMESTIC WORK ONTO OTHER WOMEN. IN ITS DEPICTION OF THE TREATMENT OF WOMEN FROM THE SOUTH BY WOMEN IN THE NORTH, THE BOOK ASKS SOME DIFFICULT QUESTIONS ABOUT THE COMMON BOND OF WOMANHOOD. PACKED WITH INFORMATION ON THE NUMBERS OF MIGRANT WOMEN WORKING AS DOMESTICS, THE RACISM, IMMIGRATION OR EMPLOYMENT LEGISLATION THAT CONSTRAINS THEIR LIVES, AND TESTIMONIES FROM THE WORKERS THEMSELVES, THIS IS THE MOST COMPREHENSIVE STUDY OF MIGRANT DOMESTIC WORKERS AVAILABLE.

WITH THE SCARLET LETTER'S HESTER PRYNNE AND ENDS WITH MOBY DICK'S QUEEQUEG. THIS STUDY LOOKS AT THE PRESENCE OF MARKED MEN AND WOMEN IN A MORE CHALLENGING ARRAY OF CANONICAL AND LESSER-KNOWN WORKS, INCLUDING EXPLORATION NARRATIVES, ROMANCES, AND FRONTIER NOVELS. JENNIFER PUTZI SHOWS HOW TATTOOS, SCARS, AND BRANDS CAN FUNCTION BOTH AS STIGMA AND AS EMBLEM OF HEALING AND SURVIVAL, THUS BLURRING THE BORDERLINE BETWEEN THE BIOLOGICAL AND SOCIAL, THE CORPOREAL AND SPIRITUAL. EXAMINING SUCH TEXTS AS TYPEE, UNCLE TOM'S CABIN, CAPTIVITY OF THE OATMAN GIRLS, THE MORGESONS, LOLA LEROY, AND CONTENDING FORCES, PUTZI RELATES THE REPRESENTATION OF THE MARKED BODY TO SIGNIFICANT EVENTS, BELIEFS, OR CULTURAL SHIFTS, INCLUDING TATTOOING AND CAPTIVITY, ROMANTIC LOVE, THE PATRIARCHAL FAMILY, AND ABOLITION AND SLAVERY. HER PARTICULAR FOCUS IS ON BOTH MEN AND WOMEN OF COLOR, AS WELL AS WHITE WOMEN--IN OTHER WORDS, BODIES THAT DID NOT SIGNIFY PERSONHOOD IN THE NINETEENTH CENTURY AND THUS BY THEIR VERY NATURE WERE GROTESQUE. COMPLICATING THE DISCOURSE ON AGENCY, POWER, AND IDENTITY, THESE TEXTS REVEAL A SURPRISINGLY COMPLEX ARRAY OF REPRESENTATIONS OF AND RESPONSES TO THE MARKED BODY--SOME THAT ARE A PRODUCT OF ESSENTIALIST THINKING ABOUT RACE AND GENDER IDENTITIES AND SOME THAT

COMPLICATE, CRITIQUE, OR EVEN REBEL AGAINST CONVENTIONAL THOUGHT.

IN THE ANTEBELLUM SOUTH, DIVORCE WAS AN EXPLOSIVE ISSUE. AS ONE LAWMAKER PUT IT, DIVORCE WAS TO BE VIEWED AS A FORM OF "MADNESS," AND AS ANOTHER ASSERTED, DIVORCE REDUCED COMMUNITIES TO THE "LOWEST EBB OF DEGENERACY." HOW WAS IT THAT IN THIS CLIMATE, THE NUMBER OF DIVORCES ROSE STEADILY DURING THE ANTEBELLUM ERA? IN FAMILIES IN CRISIS IN THE OLD SOUTH, LOREN SCHWENINGER USES PREVIOUSLY UNEXPLORED RECORDS TO ARGUE THAT THE DIFFICULTIES THESE DIVORCING FAMILIES FACED REVEAL MUCH ABOUT THE REALITY OF LIFE IN A SLAVE-HOLDING SOCIETY AS WELL AS THE MYRIAD DIFFICULTIES CONFRONTED BY WHITE SOUTHERN FAMILIES WHO CHOSE NOT TO DIVORCE. BASING HIS ARGUMENT ON ALMOST 800 DIVORCE CASES FROM THE SOUTHERN UNITED STATES, SCHWENINGER EXPLORES THE IMPACT OF DIVORCE AND SEPARATION ON WHITE FAMILIES AND ON THE ENSLAVED AND PROVIDES INSIGHTS ON ISSUES INCLUDING DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, INTERRACIAL ADULTERY, ALCOHOLISM, INSANITY, AND PROPERTY RELATIONS. HE EXAMINES HOW DIVORCE AND SEPARATION LAWS CHANGED, HOW MARRIED WOMEN'S PROPERTY RIGHTS EXPANDED, HOW DEFINITIONS OF INHUMAN TREATMENT OF WIVES EVOLVED, AND HOW THESE DIVORCES CHALLENGED CONVENTIONAL MORES.

THIS WORK DOCUMENTS THE MANY ROLES FILLED BY SOUTHERN BLACKS IN THE LAST DECADES OF SLAVERY, THE CIVIL WAR YEARS, AND THE FOLLOWING PERIOD OF RECONSTRUCTION. AFRICAN AMERICANS SUFFERED AND RESISTED BONDAGE IN VIRTUALLY EVERY ASPECT OF THEIR LIVES, BUT PERSEVERED THROUGH CENTURIES OF BRUTALITY TO THEIR PRESENT PLACE AT THE CENTER OF AMERICAN LIFE. UTILIZING STATEMENTS MADE BY FORMER SLAVES AND OTHER SOURCES CLOSE TO THEM, THE AUTHOR TAKES A CLOSE LOOK AT THE CULTURE AND LIFESTYLE OF THIS PROUD PEOPLE IN THE FINAL DECADES OF SLAVERY, THEIR EXPERIENCES OF BEING IN THE MILITARY AND FIGHTING IN THE CIVIL WAR, AND THE ACTIVE ROLE TAKEN BY THE SOUTHERN BLACKS DURING RECONSTRUCTION.

SLAVERY, GEOGRAPHY AND EMPIRE IN NINETEENTH-CENTURY MARINE LANDSCAPES OF MONTREAL AND JAMAICA IS AMONG THE FIRST SLAVERY STUDIES BOOKS - AND THE FIRST IN ART HISTORY - TO JUXTAPOSE TEMPERATE AND TROPICAL SLAVERY. CHARMAINE A. NELSON EXPLORES THE CENTRAL ROLE OF GEOGRAPHY AND ITS RACIALIZED REPRESENTATION AS LANDSCAPE ART IN IMPERIAL CONQUEST. ONE COULD EASILY ASSUME THAT NINETEENTH-CENTURY MONTREAL AND JAMAICA WERE WORLDS APART, BUT THROUGH HER ASTUTE EXAMINATION OF MARINE LANDSCAPE ART, THE AUTHOR RE-CONNECTS THESE TWO SIGNIFICANT BRITISH ISLAND COLONIES, SITES OF COLONIAL PORTS WITH PROFOUND ECONOMIC AND MILITARY VALUE. THROUGH AN ANALYSIS OF PRINTS, ILLUSTRATED TRAVEL BOOKS, AND

MAPS, THE AUTHOR EXPOSES THE FALLACY OF THEIR DISCONNECTION, ARGUING INSTEAD THAT THE SEPARATION OF THESE COLONIES WAS A RETROACTIVE FABRICATION DESIGNED IN PART TO RID CANADA OF ITS DEEPLY COLONIAL HISTORY AS AN INTEGRAL PART OF BRITAIN'S GLOBAL TRADING NETWORK WHICH ENRICHED THE MOTHERLAND THROUGH EXTENSIVE TRADE IN CROPS PRODUCED BY ENSLAVED WORKERS ON TROPICAL PLANTATIONS. THE FIRST STUDY TO EXPLORE JAMES HAKEWILL'S JAMAICAN LANDSCAPES AND WILLIAM CLARK'S ANTIGUAN GENRE STUDIES IN DEPTH, IT ALSO EXAMINES THE MONTREAL LANDSCAPES OF ARTISTS INCLUDING THOMAS DAVIES, ROBERT SPROULE, GEORGE HERIOT AND JAMES DUNCAN. BREAKING NEW GROUND, NELSON REVEALS HOW GENDER AND RACE MEDIATED THE AESTHETIC AND SCIENTIFIC ACCESS OF SUCH - MAINLY WHITE, MALE - ARTISTS. SHE ANALYZES THIS MOMENT OF DEEP POLITICAL CRISIS FOR BRITISH SLAVE OWNERS (BETWEEN THE END OF THE SLAVE TRADE IN 1807 AND COMPLETE ABOLITION IN 1833) WHO EMPLOYED VISUAL CULTURE TO IMAGINE SPACES FREE OF CONFLICT AND TO ALLEVIATE THEIR PERVASIVE ANXIETY ABOUT SLAVE RESISTANCE. NELSON EXPLORES HOW VISION AND CARTOGRAPHIC KNOWLEDGE TRANSLATED INTO AUTHORITY, WHICH ALLOWED COLONIZERS TO 'CIVILIZE' THE TERRAINS OF THE SO-CALLED NEW WORLD, WHILE BELYING THE OPPRESSION OF SLAVERY AND

INDIGENOUS DISPLACEMENT.
