Combining Badr’s own poetry with the personal narratives and creative contributions of dozens of young refugees, *While the Earth Sleeps We Travel* seeks to center and amplify the often unheard perspectives of those navigating through and beyond the complexities of displacement. The result

is a diverse and moving collection—a meditation on the concept of “home” and a testament to the power of storytelling.
