After the hands-on portion of this project, only one of the then NICU nurses did not answer all NRP based questions correctly (N=1). Conclusions: Participation in simulated neonatal resuscitation improves NICU nurses' knowledge of NRP and provides a safe place to practice and improve on resuscitation skills. Participation in simulated resuscitations should be implemented more frequently on nursing units to improve life-saving skills.
