The 'Violence against Kosovar Albanians NATO's intervention 1998-1999' case study describes the constraints and dilemmas facing Médecins Sans Frontières teams that witnessed a process of terror and expulsion which they described as the 'deportation' of Kosovar Albanians by Serb forces. It also described MSF's reaction to NATO aerial bombings and the control exercised over the refugee camps by this party to the conflict.
