DRAWING FUTURES BRINGS TOGETHER INTERNATIONAL DESIGNERS AND ARTISTS FOR SPECULATIONS IN CONTEMPORARY DRAWING FOR ART AND ARCHITECTURE. DESPITE NUMEROUS DEVELOPMENTS IN TECHNOLOGICAL MANUFACTURE AND COMPUTATIONAL DESIGN THAT PROVIDE NEW GROUNDS FOR DESIGNERS, THE ACT OF DRAWING STILL PLAYS A CENTRAL ROLE AS A VEHICLE FOR SPECULATION.
